



COOKIE POLICY

On its website, **Novatex Italia S.p.A.** (hereinafter "**Novatex**") uses only technical cookies and does not profile visitors to its website in any way.

In order to be informed about session cookies during site surfing, we invite you to read this information carefully. In fact, as clarified by the Garante della Privacy (Italian Data Protection Authority), it is necessary to make users aware of the nature of such data, even in cases where no profiling operations are carried out.

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are "information placed on your browser when you visit a website or use a social network with your devices (personal computer, smartphone, tablet, etc.)". Each cookie contains different data, e.g. the name of the server from which it comes, a numerical code, etc. These data may remain in the system for the duration of a session (i.e. until you close the browser used for web browsing) or for long periods. They may also contain a unique identification code.

2. What cookies are for?

Cookies are used to streamline the analysis of web traffic or to indicate the frequency with which a specific site or part of it is visited, as well as to distinguish between visitors in order to provide personalized content and/or help site administrators to improve the site and the users' browsing experience. Novatex cannot, by means of the cookies you download on your device, access other information stored on your device. Cookies cannot upload code of any kind nor can they carry viruses or malware, and they are not harmful to the user's terminal. Below you can find all the information about cookies installed through this site and the necessary information on how to manage your preferences in this regard.

3. User's consent

When you log on to any page of Novatex's website for the first time, you will see a brief information on the use of cookies. By closing the banner by clicking the appropriate button or outside it and continuing to navigate the site, you give your consent to our use of cookies as described in this Cookie Policy. The site stores the user's choices and therefore this policy will not be shown again if you use the same device. You do, however, have the option to revoke, partially or completely, your express consent, at any time. 4. Cookies we use

4.1. Visiting the site

The computer systems and software procedures used to run the website acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This information is not collected to be associated with



identified data subjects, but by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow the identification of the devices that connect to the site. This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users, URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) addresses of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and computer environment of the user. This data may be used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of this website and to check its correct functioning. Furthermore, this data could be used to ascertain responsibility in the event of hypothetical computer crimes against Novatex's website.

4.2. Data provided voluntarily by users

The optional, explicit and voluntary sending of personal data to access certain services or to make requests for information to the addresses indicated on the website, involves the subsequent acquisition of the personal data included in the sender's request, necessary for navigation. Specific brief information, prepared for particular on-demand services, will be progressively reported or displayed on the website pages.

4.3. Table of first-party cookies, i.e. directly issued by Novatex

COOKIE	DESCRIPTION
⟨TECHNICAL⟩	It is not necessary to give your consent.
⟨SESSION⟩ ⟨NAVIGATION⟩	They are essential for the proper functioning of our site and allow the user to navigate it and view its content. If deactivated, it would cause a malfunctioning of the site. They are necessary, for example, to keep a navigation session open or to allow the temporary memorising of the texts entered by the user when filling out a form.
⟨FUNCTIONAL⟩	They allow the user to make the most of the peculiarities of the site and to enjoy a better navigation. The site works best if these cookies are enabled, but it is possible for the user to disable them. Cookies of this type, for example, remember in which language the user prefers to view content.
⟨CONSENT⟩	These cookies keep track of the consent to their use given by the user, so as not to show again - on subsequent visits - the brief information on cookies and the request for consent.



4.4. Statistics cookies (third-parties cookies)

Novatex uses *Google Analytics*, a web traffic analysis service provided by Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway - Mountain View - CA94043 USA (hereinafter, "**Google**"), which uses cookies to collect and analyse aggregate information about the users' browsing experience. Neither Novatex nor Google associate your IP address with any other data they possess to directly identify you.

The information collected is processed by *Google Analytics* systems in order to produce reports for the administrators of this website, who use it to verify the correct functioning of the services and, if necessary, the rate of appreciation of the content offered by Novatex.
